

  - Meet with School Teams/Staffs in every school & across departments
  - Community Tour visit every school & community centers
  - Meetings with Strategic Community Groups

## **Board of Education Approval & Publication**

Phase III: June - September, 2018

- Create Draft Report from what we've learned from World Café,
   Thought Exchange & Engagement Processes
- Receive summative input and recommendations from the Board
- Publish Final Strategic Plan to Board of Education
- Target date: June Sept, 2018
- Publish video & share Strategic Plan with Ann Arbor community
