



Early Childhood Camps

Most are for 3 - 5.5 year olds

Half-day AM or PM

Art, science, early literacy, dance, music, Spanish, creative play

Outside play and free choice time



Safety Town Program

- Rising Y5, Kinder, and 1st graders
- 4 week-long sessions, half-day AM with afternoon camp option

- Young children learn to evaluate safe from unsafe in potentially dangerous situations
- Partners include AAFD, AAPD, Huron Valley Safe Kids, and more









Camps for 5-14 year olds

Enrichment Camps

- Wide variety of camp themes, from art to robotics to nature and theater
- Hands-on, interactive activities with outdoor time and free play
- Full and half day
- Main camp location offers after care until 5:30 p.m.

Sports Camps

- A2Sports Multi-sport camps for 5-13 year olds
- <u>Individual sport camps</u> for 5-14 year olds
- Full and half day
- Focus on fun, introduction to the sport or skill development, teamwork
