

Options Program at Pioneer

- The Options program is a web-based learning resource where students can earn high school credit, while learning independently in an online classroom, after school.

Requirements:

- o Work for at least 6 hours per course per week. (12 hours per week for 2 courses)
- o Stay current (or 'on track') in all courses.
- o Work silently during lab time.
- o Respect school rules, equipment, and fellow students.
- o While in work lab, no programs or websites other than school related can be open.
- o Take careful notes on paper.
- o Bring a notebook, highlighter, pencil and headphones (with cord/no Bluetooth) to each class.

Lab hours are an opportunity to accomplish a lot of work with the support of an in-person highly qualified mentor teacher.

We provide students with:

- o A quiet space to learn.
- o A reliable Internet connection.
- o A desktop, iPad, or laptop.
- o In-person feedback and support.

The required lab time is set up for students to maximize their performance on their online coursework through e2020.

Mentor teachers will help students with:

- o Course administration and navigation.
- o Test-taking and study skill strategies.
- o Content learning support.
- o Pacing guide support.
- o Email support outside of lab hour class times.

Time Commitment:

Students will need to dedicate at least 6 hours per week on each course to stay on track. Students will also need to commit to working on their courses outside of class.
