



Daily Student Pre-Screening for COVID-19 Symptoms and Exposure

Updated 9/17/2021

Help keep your student's school healthy and safe for all!

Parents/guardians are responsible for reviewing and responding to the questions below each day that their student will attend school in person.

1. In the past 24 hours, has your student experienced any of the following **NEW** or **UNEXPECTED** symptoms:

If YES → Stay home, have your student tested (rapid antigen or PCR), or contact your child's health care provider for a diagnosis other than COVID-19.

2. In the past week, has anyone **in your household** been diagnosed with COVID-19?

If YES, your student is considered a household close contact. See the Washtenaw County Health Department's [FAQ for Parents on Isolation and Quarantine](#). Keep the infected person isolated from your student. Follow the directions below depending on your student's vaccination status, and contact your school nurse with questions:

- **Vaccinated student:** Continue regular activities if asymptomatic. Get a PCR test 3-5 days after exposure and mask up in public indoor spaces for 10 days from last exposure.
- **Unvaccinated student:** Quarantine for 10 days from the date of last close contact with the infected individual. Get tested at least once during the quarantine period.

3. In the past week, has your student been in close contact with anyone outside the home (not at school) who has a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19? The WCHD defines a community “Close contact” as someone who spends 15+ minutes within 6 feet of an infected person. See WCHD [FAQ for Parents on Isolation and Quarantine](#) for more information.

If YES → Follow instructions in number 2, above.
