

**\*\*\* Schools of Choice Application Window May 1 – May 30, 2023 \*\*\*  
Parents will be notified of their application status by June 13, 2023.**

**For Students Residing Outside the Ann Arbor Public Schools Attendance Boundaries**

The Ann Arbor Board of Education has approved a non-resident student enrollment policy under Section 105 and 105C of the School Aid Act (MCL 388.1705) that allows for a limited number of seats in buildings listed below for students not living within the Ann Arbor Public School District. Students living in a school district within the following ISDs: Washtenaw, Ingham, Jackson, Lenawee, Livingston, Monroe, Oakland and Wayne may apply to enroll.

**Please note:**

- **Transportation to and from school will not be provided by AAPS.** Transportation is the responsibility of the parent or guardian. The ability of a family to transport students to arrive on time to school and be picked up on time is an important consideration when applying for Schools of Choice. Please consider this carefully.
- **All high school transfer students may be subject to an athletic ineligibility period per MHSAA policy.** For more information, please contact the athletic director at the school you have been approved for Schools of Choice admission.

**Application Process:**

- Parents wishing to apply for a Schools of Choice admission must complete an **online** application for each student. The application deadline is **Tuesday, May 30, 2023 at 11:59 P.M.** You will find the online application at <http://www.a2schools.org/enroll>
- Applications are accepted anytime within the application window time frame. *By law, late applications cannot be accepted.* **Applications are NOT processed on a first-come, first-served basis.**
- Applications will be reviewed for accurate information. This may involve contacting the student’s current school.
- Student acceptance is conditional until Ann Arbor Public Schools receives and reviews all school discipline records.
- Once approved and enrolled, the student may remain in the Ann Arbor Public Schools through graduation. This does not prohibit the Ann Arbor Public Schools from expelling a student for disciplinary reasons.
- **Number of seats available at each building and/or grade may be limited.**
- If the number of qualified non-resident applications eligible for acceptance exceeds the number of seats available, students who reside in the same household as students enrolled through Schools of Choice in the 2022/23 school year will receive first consideration. A random draw system will be used to determine selection for the remaining spaces. A waitlist may be maintained for the remaining applications and prioritized through the random draw.

**Enrollment is limited to:** Schools of Choice enrollment for the 2023-24 school year will be limited. The district will determine the number of spaces at each building and grade after the application window closes. **The application window, buildings and grades posted are tentative and subject to change prior to May 1, 2023.** The SOC application window is subject to review and update by the AAPS Board of Education. *Details regarding the availability of Ann Arbor Public Schools Elementary Virtual Village (A2Virtual Elementary) and A2Virtual courses for middle school and high school students are pending and will be posted, as applicable, after student school assignments have been established.*
