A few quick reminders as we prepare to welcome your future Golden Bears to Slauson!

5th Grade Transition Day- May 1st

On May 1st, your child will have the opportunity to visit Slauson Middle School. The Slauson staff is looking forward to welcoming our future Golden Bears! Slauson t-shirts will be delivered to each 5th grade teacher to distribute prior to May 1st for all visiting students to wear during the transition day visit. Students from non-feeder elementary schools who have been approved via AAPS In-District Transfer will be responsible for transportation to Slauson on May 1st for transition activities. T-shirts will be available for these students in the Main Office on May 1st.

5th Grade Family Fun Night- May 3rd

All incoming 6th grade families are invited to attend the PTSO sponsored Family Fun Night at Slauson Middle School on May 3rd. This event is *only* open to current 5th grade students and families who are designated to attend Slauson in the fall. **5th graders must be accompanied by a parent/guardian and may not be dropped off for this event.** The pool will be open for swimming, along with activities and pizza! There is no cost to attend this event.

Slauson Middle School August Registration

Save the date: August 22, 2019! All incoming 6th grade students will be able to register on this date. Registration includes receiving student schedules, student I.D. cards, locker assignments, and taking a yearbook picture. Class schedules can also be used to explore and locate classrooms, as well as meet teachers who may be available and present on this day. If your family will not be available on 8/22/19, it will be possible for your child to receive these items on the first day of school.

Advanced Math Options for Incoming 6th Graders

Any student currently taking advanced online math will have the option to take a seated class as an alternative to online math in 6th grade. Students who test-out or are currently on track to take Math 7 are encouraged to select a seated class. Every effort is made to place all 6th graders taking a seated Math 7 course in the same section. Please email the Main Office (chabot@aaps.k12.mi.us) to indicate your preference for taking Math 7 in either a seated traditional class or in an online class by June, 2019. Note "Math Placement" in the subject line.
