## May 2022 IB Diploma Program Examinations Information for Students and Families

Dear Huron 11th/12th IB Students and Parents/Guardians,

Diploma Programme exams are scheduled from April 28th through May 20th. This year at Huron we are expecting to administer nearly 1,000 DP exams! We are excited that you/your child will be participating along with students from 5,000 other schools world-wide!

**Please read the following information carefully. Please ask for clarification at the Huron IB Office, room 6158 or your Diploma Programme class teacher.**



**Location:** Exams this year will be administered at Huron High School. Most exams will be held in the Lower Gymnasium. Some exams, including those for students with extended time, will be held in the Principal's Conference Room (PCR) near the main office.

*Reminder: There are no make ups for Diploma Programme exams.*

### **Reporting for exams:**

Students should report for exams at the time listed on the May 2022 IB Exam Schedule. Students should be checked in and seated 10 minutes prior to the start of each examination. Exams will start on-time. Students should plan carefully to not be late.

### **Exam duration and dismissal:**

Students must complete the examination in the time allotted for each paper. Once time has been called, you may not make any more marks on your answer booklet, not even to transfer answers. Please pace yourself and write answers according to the guidelines within the time allowed.









Students are not permitted to leave the examination room within the first 60 minutes, nor within the last 15 minutes of an examination. Prior to leaving an examination, the student must have their answer booklets verified by a proctor.

The mission of Ann Arbor Huron High School is to inspire and advance academic achievement for all students through excellence in teaching, learning and equitable practices. Students will be challenged to be successful, caring, life-long learners and active members of the global community.



### **What to bring to exams:**

Students can expect that individual DP teachers will communicate about the exact items to bring on exam day. Some general guidelines that apply to all exams are:

### **Calculators:**

In addition, calculators are permitted for the following exams:

- Business Management
- Biology, paper 2 only
- Chemistry, paper 2 only
- Environmental Systems and Societies
- Physics, paper 2 only

Graphic Display Calculator:

- Math A&A SL, paper 2 only
- Math A&A HL, paper 2 & 3
- Math A&I SL and HL

Your DP class teacher can verify whether your personal calculator is permitted or prohibited and give guidance on necessary actions with permitted calculators. If you enter the examination space without a permitted calculator, you may have to take the exam without a calculator.

**What to not bring to exams:**

Smartphones, smart watches or technology that connects to the Internet is NOT allowed. If these items are brought to exams, they will be powered down, turned in during testing, and returned to students after testing.

Bags, purses and backpacks cannot be near students during examinations. They can be left at the rear of the gymnasium. This is not a secure storage location. All items (including laptops, cell phones, or smart devices including wearable technology) should be powered down and study material should be packed away to avoid suspicion.

**Inclusive Testing / Accommodations / Extended Time:**

Students with identified disabilities as part of an Individualized Education Plan or section 504 plan are eligible to receive accommodations as listed in their respective plan as permitted by the International Baccalaureate Organization examination guidelines. These were requested by students and approved by IB at the time of registration. Only the approved accommodations can be given during this testing session. All approved students were notified.

Note for students who have **extended time** as part of their accommodation plan: Extended time on IB Diploma Programme exams may go past the scheduled end of the school day. In these situations, we ask the student or family to arrange transportation home immediately following the examination. (All projected examination times are noted on the examination schedule.)

**Examinations that run beyond the end of the school day**

When students have an exam that goes beyond the school day, we ask the student or family to arrange transportation home immediately following the examination. All projected examination times are noted on the examination schedule.

\* Note: Thursday, May 5th is an Early Release at Huron High School to allow for 8th grade Transition Day. *IB EXAMS WILL CONTINUE AS PLANNED.* All students will receive a bagged lunch between the end of school and the beginning of your DP exam. Testing students must arrange transportation home after DP Examinations on May 5th. Additional information to follow from your DP Teachers.

***Exam Conflicts - more than one exam in a morning or afternoon:***

Students with more than one exam scheduled in a morning or afternoon will have an adjusted testing schedule that will allow them to complete both exams during the allotted time. Students with these conflicts will be notified with ample time to plan accordingly.

***Lunch (only for students who have both an AM and PM exam on a given day):***

If students have both a morning and afternoon exam on a given day, they should bring their own lunch to exams. A space to eat in between exams will be provided. Students will **not** be released to purchase lunch during an examination.

Additionally,

- When an afternoon exam begins at 11:40am, students will be excused for early lunch that day.
- When a morning exam ends in the 11 o'clock hour, students will be excused through late lunch that day.

Only clear, contained water will be allowed near a student while testing. Food and snacks can be eaten outside of the examination room before/after the examination.

***Exam Day Absences or Emergencies***

The Huron IB Facilitators will excuse attendance during the specific dates/times that students miss class for examinations. Families should not call to report their child's absence for a scheduled DP examination. Please note: Students will not be excused for a full day if, for example, their examination does not start until the afternoon.

If you encounter a last minute emergency, please contact Ms. James via her Google Voice number at (248) 509-4757. This number will receive voice and text messages. There is a small window for discretion if a student is briefly late with a valid reason (ex. verifiable traffic incident) so please communicate!

***IB Results***

All testing students must complete this [Huron IB Student College and Address Form](#) by May 1st. This is what we will use to send IB scores to colleges for our graduating students. Additionally, this is how we will send earned IB Certificates and Diplomas in the fall.

# Notice to candidates

The following instructions must be observed for all IB examinations. Failure to comply may result in no grade being awarded for the subject being examined.

If you do not understand these instructions, please contact your coordinator.



Arrive on time for your examination. You are not permitted to leave the examination within the first 60 minutes, or the last 15 minutes.



Do not communicate with other candidates in the examination room.



Do not bring any unauthorized materials to your desk.



Follow all invigilator instructions. Raise your hand if you require the invigilator's attention.



Do not take any examination material out of the examination room.



Ensure that you report any incidents of possible misconduct to your coordinator.



Do not discuss the content of the examination outside of your immediate cohort in the next 24 hours.

## Conduct of the examinations

# Items not permitted

If you take any of the following items into an IB examination – *even by mistake* – you will be in breach of regulations and may not be eligible for a grade in the subject being examined.

If you do not understand these instructions, please contact your coordinator.



### Electronic equipment

An approved calculator is permitted in certain examinations.



### Wearable technology

Note that this includes, but is not limited to, smart watches, smart glasses, and wireless headphones.



### Books or guides



### Rough/scratch paper or notes



### Refreshments

Water is permitted at the discretion of the coordinator.
