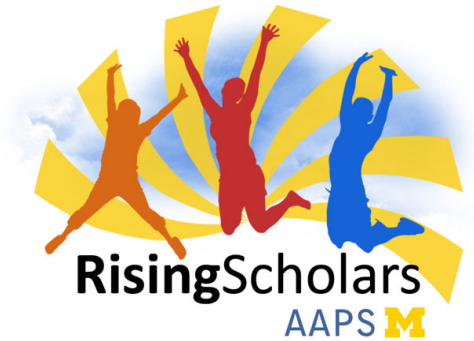


Hello Huron Families,

The Huron Rising Scholars Parent Alliance (HRSPA) was founded to support the Rising Scholars Program at Huron High School. The program is to help AAPS students prepare for college through service opportunities and academic enrichment.



Saturday School is the Rising Scholars biggest service event. It is held three times per year on the Saturdays leading up to first and second semester exams. The event provides a time and place for students to get together and study for exams. The Rising Scholars, their parents and their advisors, Mrs. RaShonda Jamerson, Rising Scholar Counselor, and Mr. Kenyatta Tucker, Huron Teacher, arrange the event and invite all Huron High School students. Teachers and tutors attend to help guide students and answer questions. To help them focus, all students and staff are provided with a hot breakfast, including pancakes, eggs, bacon, grits, toast, etc. This breakfast is bought, prepared and served by the Rising Scholar team. The event has grown in popularity. This last year we served over 250 students and staff in one day.
