
Mr. Fisher's last day at Thurston will be this Friday April 28.

Disability Awareness Month

This month at Thurston we have been learning about disability, neurodiversity and difference. In this final week of April, we are focusing on Learning Differences. Some of us have specific learning disability areas that can be identified through a Special Education Evaluation at school. These disability areas include: listening comprehension, oral expression, basic reading, reading fluency, reading comprehension, mathematics calculation, mathematics problem solving and written expression. The goal of inclusion at school is to welcome and support learners of various abilities working side-by-side.

As we continue to learn about how others experience the world around us, we encourage families to explore these differences as well.


