This letter is to inform you that we have been notified of a case of COVID-19 at Huron High School. At this time, we are focusing on following up with known positive cases and conducting contact tracing for higher-risk exposures. If you are not individually contacted, by email or phone, then no action is necessary, though we encourage you to monitor your health.
