Dear Haisley Families,

This letter is to inform you that we have been notified of one student at Haisley who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 24 hours. These individuals were last at Haisley on Wednesday, September 8, 2021.

The AAPS COVID-19 Response Team is conducting the district contact tracing protocol in consultation with the Washtenaw County Health Department. The families of students who were in close contact with the infected individual and need to quarantine have been notified.

As always, make sure you are observing your student for COVID-19 symptoms every day before they come to school. The student health questionnaire is linked [HERE](#).

If you or your child are experiencing even mild symptoms, please consider getting tested. If there are no symptoms, the Washtenaw County Health Dept recommends waiting 3 or more days after the potential exposure to get tested. The WCHD has information about testing locations [HERE](#).

Please note that privacy regulations restrict us from sharing identifying or personal information about the individual(s) who have been diagnosed with COVID-19.

This situation reinforces the importance of consistently following all COVID-19 mitigation strategies and protocols. These include vaccination for everyone ages 12 and up, consistent use of face coverings, maintaining social distance, and hand sanitization, among others.
