Dear Eberwhite Community,

This letter is to inform you that we have been notified of additional cases of COVID-19 at Eberwhite in the kindergarten and in special education program. The positive cases have been asked to isolate according to AAPS protocols. Privacy regulations restrict us from sharing identifying/personal information about the individual(s) who have been diagnosed with COVID-19.

At this time, we are focusing on following up with known positive cases and conducting contact tracing for any higher-risk exposures as defined in the [AAPS K12 Guidance](#). If you are not individually contacted, by email or phone, then no action is necessary.

As a reminder, we need everyone to do their part to help minimize the spread of COVID-19 in our schools. This includes:

- Monitoring your child for *any* COVID symptoms using the [Daily Student Pre-Screening for COVID-19 Symptoms](#),
- **Keep your student home with even mild symptoms**, get tested, and quarantine until results come back.
- Ensuring your child wears a tight-fitting mask to school
- Getting your student vaccinated and boosted
- Getting your student tested as needed based on symptoms and exposure to others who test positive. [CLICK HERE](#) for a list of community testing sites.
