Dear Eberwhite Community,

This letter is to inform you that we have been notified of COVID-19 cases at Eberwhite in the 1st grade, 4th grade, and special education programs. The positive cases have been asked to isolate according to AAPS protocols. Privacy regulations restrict us from sharing identifying/personal information about the individual(s) who have been diagnosed with COVID-19.

At this time, we are focusing on following up with known positive cases and conducting contact tracing for any higher-risk exposures as defined in the <u>AAPS K12 Guidance</u>. If you are not individually contacted, by email or phone, then no action is necessary.

As a reminder, we need everyone to do their part to help minimize the spread of COVID-19 in our schools. This includes:

- Monitoring your child for any COVID symptoms using the <u>Daily Student Pre-Screening</u> for COVID-19 Symptoms,
- **Keep your student home with <u>even mild</u> symptoms**, get tested, and quarantine until results come back.
- Ensuring your child wears a tight-fitting mask to school
- Getting your student vaccinated and boosted
- Getting your student tested as needed based on symptoms and exposure to others who test positive. <u>CLICK HERE</u> for a list of community testing sites.
