Dear Eberwhite Community,

This letter is to inform you that we have been notified of COVID-19 cases at Eberwhite this week. There have been three total cases this week in the kindergarten, 4th-grade, and special education. The positive case has been asked to isolate according to AAPS protocols. Privacy regulations restrict us from sharing identifying/personal information about the individual(s) who have been diagnosed with COVID-19.

At this time, we are focusing on following up with known positive cases and conducting contact tracing for any higher-risk exposures as defined in the [AAPS K12 Guidance](#). If you are not individually contacted, by email or phone, then no action is necessary.

As a reminder, we need everyone to do their part to help minimize the spread of COVID-19 in our schools. This includes:

- Monitoring your child for *any* COVID symptoms using the [Daily Student Pre-Screening for COVID-19 Symptoms](#),
- **Keep your student home with even mild symptoms**, get tested, and stay home until results come back. [CLICK HERE](#) for a list of community testing sites.
- Ensuring your child wears a tight-fitting mask to school
- Getting your student vaccinated and boosted
