Dear Lawton Community,

This letter is to inform you that we have been notified of 4 cases of COVID-19 at Lawton Elementary. Positive cases have been asked to isolate according to AAPS protocols. Privacy regulations restrict us from sharing identifying/personal information about the individual(s) who have been diagnosed with COVID-19. The people who tested positive were last in the building on **Friday, April 29th, and Monday, May 2nd.**

At this time, we are focusing on following up with known positive cases and conducting contact tracing for any higher-risk exposures. If further action is needed, you will be contacted by email or phone.

**As a reminder, we need everyone to do their part to help minimize the spread of COVID-19 in our schools. This includes:**

- Monitoring your child for *any* COVID symptoms using the [Daily Student Pre-Screening for COVID-19 Symptoms](#),
- **Keep your student home with even mild symptoms**, get tested, and stay home until results come back. [CLICK HERE](#) for a list of community testing sites.
- Ensuring your child wears a tight-fitting mask to school
- Getting your student vaccinated and boosted
