Dear Lawton Community,

This letter is to inform you that we have been notified of 4 cases of COVID-19 at Lawton Elementary. Positive cases have been asked to isolate according to AAPS protocols. Privacy regulations restrict us from sharing identifying/personal information about the individual(s) who have been diagnosed with COVID-19. The people who tested positive were last in the building on Tuesday, May 11th.

At this time, we are focusing on following up with known positive cases and conducting contact tracing for any higher-risk exposures. If further action is needed, you will be contacted by email or phone.

**As a reminder, we need everyone to do their part to help minimize the spread of COVID-19 in our schools. This includes:**

- Monitoring your child for *any* COVID symptoms using the [Daily Student Pre-Screening for COVID-19 Symptoms](#),
- **Keep your student home with even mild symptoms**, get tested, and stay home until results come back. [CLICK HERE](#) for a list of community testing sites.
- Ensuring your child wears a tight-fitting mask to school
- Getting your student vaccinated and boosted
