Dear Mitchell School Community,

In accordance with the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) guidelines for schools, I am communicating that there are two confirmed cases of COVID-19 at Mitchell Elementary School.

Our AAPS COVID-19 Response Team has conducted the district contact tracing protocol in consultation with the Washtenaw County Health Department. **It has been determined that there are no close contacts and in person learning can continue.** If something changes, we will notify you as soon as possible.

As always, make sure you are observing your student for COVID-19 symptoms every day before they come to school. The student health questionnaire is linked [HERE](#).

If your student(s) are experiencing even mild symptoms, please get them tested. The WCHD has information about testing locations [HERE](#).

Please note that privacy regulations restrict us from sharing identifying/personal information about the individual(s) who have been diagnosed with COVID-19.

This situation reinforces the importance of consistently following all COVID-19 mitigation strategies and protocols. These include vaccination for everyone ages 5 and up, consistent use of face coverings, maintaining social distance, and hand sanitization, among others.
