This letter is to inform you that we have been notified of three cases of COVID-19 at Wines. Positive cases have been asked to isolate according to AAPS protocols. Privacy regulations restrict us from sharing identifying/personal information about the individual(s) who have been diagnosed with COVID-19.

At this time, we are focusing on following up with known positive cases and conducting contact tracing for any higher-risk exposures. If further action is needed, you will be contacted by email or phone.

As a reminder, we need everyone to do their part to help minimize the spread of COVID-19 in our schools. This includes:

- Monitoring your child for any COVID symptoms using the [Daily Student Pre-Screening for COVID-19 Symptoms](#),

- Ensuring your child wears a tight-fitting mask to school
- Getting your student vaccinated and boosted
