Dear parents of students who attended the science class at A2 STEAM on 11/3,

Yesterday, we were notified that an individual who tested positive for COVID-19 was present at the after-school science class at A2 STEAM on Wednesday, November 3. Please note that privacy regulations restrict us from sharing identifying or personal information about the individual who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

The AAPS COVID-19 Response Team has conducted the district contact tracing protocol in consultation with the Washtenaw County Health Department (WCHD). The investigation found that **there were no close contacts during the after-school science class.**

The Washtenaw County Health Department recommends that the science class participants and all of their family members closely monitor themselves for symptoms over the next 14 days. The student health questionnaire is linked here: [Daily Student Pre-Screening for COVID-19 Symptoms](#).
