## FULL IB Career-related Programme



### Guidelines for students selecting a FULL IB Career-related Programme schedule:

**Career-related Programme Students** will create a schedule based on the following criteria:

1. Choose one course in their chosen Career-Related Study Area for all 4 semesters of 11th and 12th grade.
2. Students will select a minimum of 2 DP classes from Groups 1, 3, 4, 5, or 6.
  - One of those courses must be a two year course.
  - The other course can be a one or two year course.
  - There is no requirement for Higher Level (HL) or Standard Level (SL) courses
  - Group 2 DP courses cannot count toward the 2 minimum, but can be used as a third DP selection.
3. Students must select CP Core Advisory for all 4 semesters of 11th and 12th grades.
4. All AAPS graduation requirements must be satisfied.

### Guidelines for students selecting a FULL IB Diploma Programme schedule:

Diploma Programme Students will create a schedule based on the following criteria:

1. To be full DP, students need to choose DP courses in 6 subject areas (see DP 4 year plan link for guidance on Group 6 options)
2. Students must select 3 courses at the Standard Level (SL) and 3 courses at the Higher Level (HL)
3. Students must take DP Core Advisory for all 4 semesters of 11th and 12th grades.
4. All AAPS graduation requirements must be satisfied.

<b>DP Group 5 Choices:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• DP Math Application and Interpretation SL (two years)</li><li>• DP Math Application and Interpretation HL (two years)</li><li>• DP Math Analysis and Approaches SL (two years)</li><li>• DP Math Analysis and Approaches HL (two years)</li></ul>
<b>DP Group 6 Choices:</b> <i>* Full DP students can take an additional group 2, 3, or 4 class instead of choosing a group 6 class.</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• DP Visual Arts SL or HL (two years)</li><li>• DP Film SL or HL (two years)</li></ul>
