Guidelines for students selecting a FULL IB Career-related Programme schedule:

Career-related Programme Students will create a schedule based on the following criteria:

1. Choose one course in their chosen Career-Related Study Area for all 4 semesters of 11th and 12th grade.
2. Students will select a minimum of 2 DP classes from Groups 1, 3, 4, 5, or 6.
 - One of those courses must be a two year course.
 - The other course can be a one or two year course.
 - There is no requirement for Higher Level (HL) or Standard Level (SL) courses
 - Group 2 DP courses cannot count toward the 2 minimum, but can be used as a third DP selection.
3. Students must select CP Core Advisory for all 4 semesters of 11th and 12th grades.
4. All AAPS graduation requirements must be satisfied.
